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| Candidate Experience - Admin Portal - Add description for the 'State/Location' application form field | OH-39764    |              | Informational text added when selecting the State/Location option from the Field drop-down: <i>This field will need to be placed on the same page as the 'Country of Residence' field, in order for the drop-down to populate with the states/regions/provinces of the selected country. Best practice would be to place it somewhere underneath the 'Country of Residence' field.</i> |
